Usaburo Kokeshi* Toranomon, wooden dolls measuring 10cm (H) x 5.8cm (W), are handmade by craftsmen in Gunma Prefecture. Each doll varies slightly in style, color and/or size. *Kokeshi* dolls featuring the beloved anime characters Doraemon and Dorami also will be on sale.

*Kokeshi are Japanese wooden dolls with simple trunks and enlarged heads.





Toranomon Stuffed Animal (3,780 JPY)

In response to numerous requests from customers, a Toranomon stuffed animal measuring 27cm (H) x 21cm (W) will be added to the Toranomon lineup. The stuffed animal will be sold only at Art & Design store located in Toranomon Hills.
