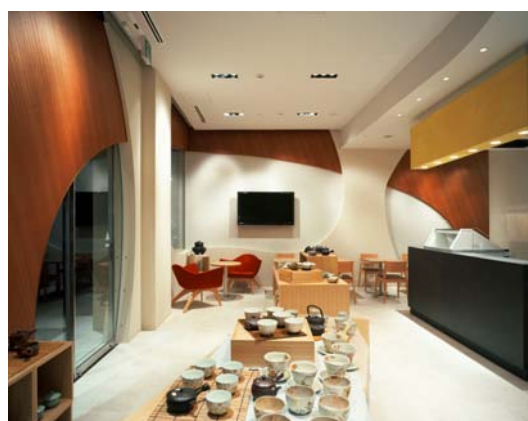


Mori Building Interiors Unit Receives Special Award in Shop Design Contest ~Interior services business to expand by actively targeting outside projects~
