## Popular free shuttle bus service between Roppongi Hills and The National Art Center, Tokyo returns for a limited time during the summer holidays

Creating developments that aim at community vitalization through cultural offerings, Mori Building Co., Ltd. The shuttle bus adds the dimension of even more convenient transportation to explore the Roppongi area, which is attracting even more attention with the recent opening of Tokyo Midtown.

Operation Period: Everyday from July 28 (Sat) to August 26 (Sun), 2007 except Tuesdays.

Over 23,000 Visitors took Advantage of the Spring Shuttle Bus (average: approx. 1,000 passengers daily)

Operating only on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays during the spring holidays in 2007, the special shuttle bus service between Roppongi Hills and The National Art Center, Tokyo, carried a cumulative total of over 23,000 visitors, with all buses between 12:00 and 18:59 filled to near 100% capacity. Based on the popularity of this service in spring, the shuttle bus will again be carrying visitors between these two popular destinations during the summer holidays, but with greatly expanded service days.
